

IT IS AGAINST THE LAW to sell or supply liquor to a drunk person.

You can be considered to be drunk if:

- Your speech, balance, coordination or behaviour appears to be noticeably impaired.
- It is reasonable to believe that your impairment results from the consumption of liquor.
